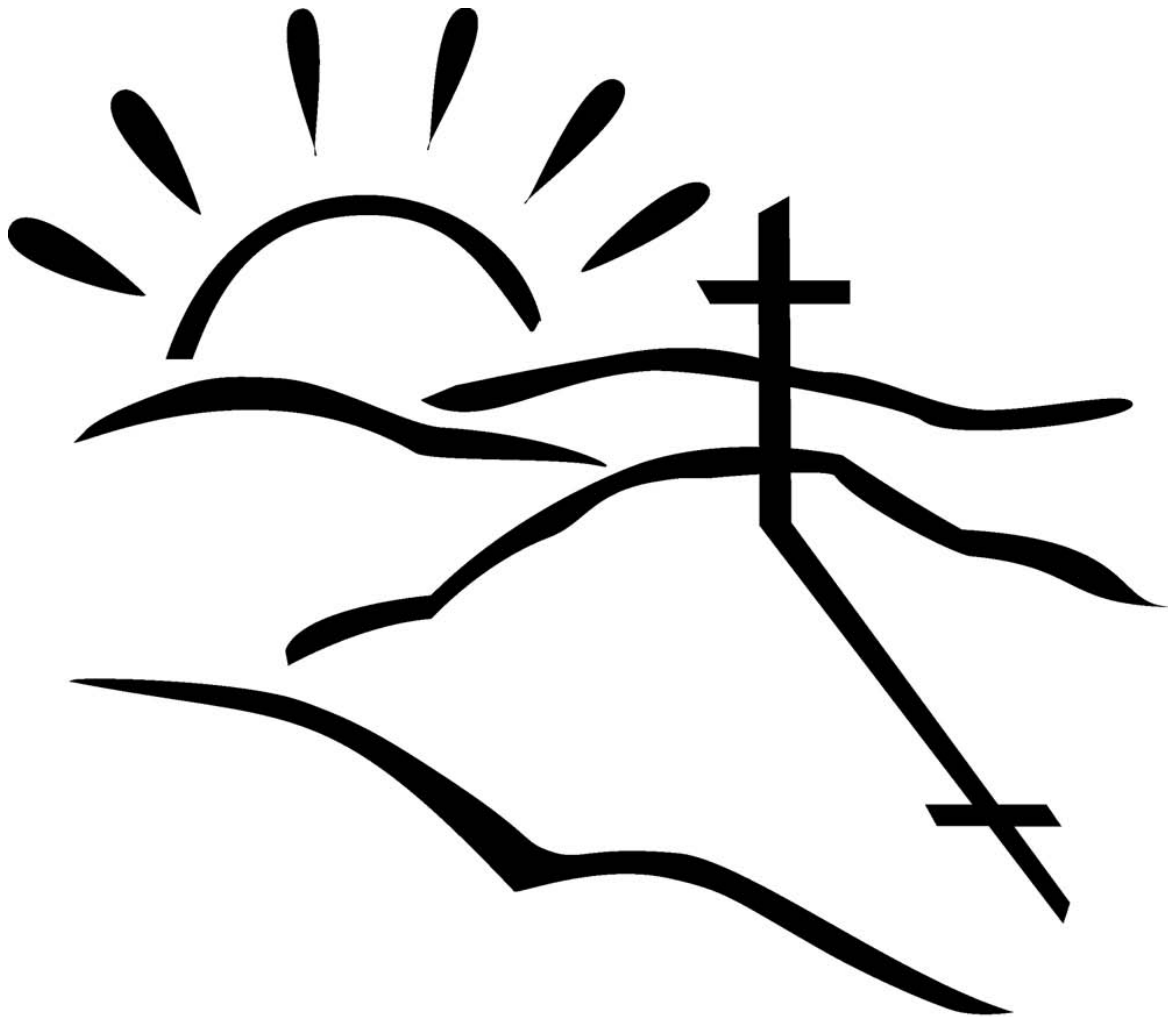

Reflection on the 1st Reading (Acts 10:34A, 37-43):

“I truly understand that God shows no partiality, but in every nation anyone who fears Him and does what is right is acceptable to Him.” – starts Peter his speech given at the house of Gentile Cornelius (Peter’s 5th discourse in Acts of the Apostles). Peter reassures that the Good News of Jesus is for them as well as for the Jews. “Everyone who believes in Him will receive forgiveness of sins through His name.” Peter tells the story of Jesus, beginning with His ministry in Galilee. Each speech is both instruction and an invitation to conversion. In Jesus’ entire life “He went about doing good.” Peter then continues and tells about Jesus’ Resurrection: “God raised Him on the third day.” This is the earliest and most fundamental proclamation, and the heart of each of the speeches. Jesus’ acts of “doing good” during His life time will continue, now that He has been raised from the dead. He will offer forgiveness to everyone who believes in Him. Peter’s words are an invitation to faith and righteous living in response to the Resurrection of Jesus. *Excerpt from 2018 Workbook for Lectors, Gospel Readers and Proclaimers of the Word*

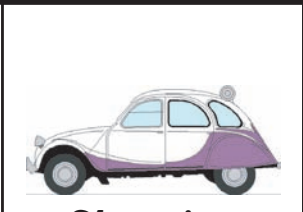

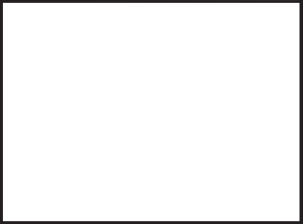
