

John L. Allen Jr., The Francis Miracle: Inside the Transformation of the Pope and the Church



OUR 125TH ANNIVERSARY – ST. LOUIS REMEMBERS:

Three organs have been installed in the choir loft over the years. On Palm Sunday, 1901, parishioners rejoiced as their hymns (probably sung in English, Latin and/or German that day),

were accompanied by the newly acquired two-manual pedal organ, built by Walter Spencer of Hamilton (\$1,200).

In 1949, a Hallman Electronic organ was installed as a memorial to the men of St. Louis who died in action during the Second World War (\$4,000).

In 1965, one of the projects to celebrate St. Louis' 75th Anniversary, was the installation of our present Hallman pipe organ, donated in memory of the deceased members of the Bauer family.


