Sacramental Life

Church policy requires that the Sacraments be performed in the parish located closest to you geographically – unless you are registered and regularly attend elsewhere. At St. Louis, the sacraments of initiation are available to registered and regularly attending parishioners only.

Baptism: Celebrated once a month. Please contact the parish office for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Tuesdays – Fridays before the morning Mass, Saturdays 4 - 4:30 p.m., or by appointment.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least one year in advance of your date. A marriage preparation course is required.

R.C.I.A: Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, preparing adults for baptism and/or to join the community. Please contact the office for further information.

Anointing and Pastoral Care: Our parish community cares about the sick and elderly and the lonely. Please notify the parish office to arrange for Sacrament of Reconciliation, Holy Communion, or Sacrament of the Sick.

Pastoral Care to those in Hospital: Privacy-of-Information laws prohibit the parish from obtaining information about parishioners in the hospital. A family member is asked to contact the parish whenever a parishioner is in hospital and requests a pastoral visit.

Mission Statement
St. Louis Parish is a welcoming and caring Roman Catholic community. We reflect the presence of the Risen Christ among us, as we grow together in Faith, Hope and Love.

For the Feast of Corpus Christi (Body of Christ):

"Where can we find God?" The immediate response is: "He is everywhere." But being everywhere in general is being nowhere in particular. The big quest is to find God uniquely, specifically, and individually... and to encounter God in our natural human experience, not just supernaturally. God revealed Himself to us and spoke to us through prophets and holy people in the Old Testament. But that's like meeting God through letters or e-mails. We want to be close up and personal with those we love. It's only natural, that we should have that drive within us when we are conscious of loving God and want Him to be close to us. God knows that. 2,000 years ago, God came to us in His only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ. But what about today? Jesus is responding to our want and need. Catholics encounter God in Christ very personally, even intimately in His Body and Blood, in the Eucharist, in the Blessed Sacrament. It's really

Him. For us, Holy Communion isn't just pretty poetry. In the 6th Chapter of St. John's Gospel Jesus declared: "*For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. They who eat my flesh and drinks my blood live in me and I live in them.*" It is God's response to our quest. God comes to us in our need and want to be close to Him. He gives Himself completely to us in Holy Communion. Many people cannot accept that gift. And indeed just moments after Jesus gave this teaching to His disciples, the doubters raised their objections. St. John reports that after hearing it, many of His followers said, "*This is intolerable language. How could anyone accept it?...*" After this, many of His disciples left him..." Jesus did not go running after them, calling them back. He didn't say to them, "Come on back, I was only speaking poetically." No! He simply let them go. And then He turned to the Twelve apostles and asked them: "*What about you, do you want to go away too?*" Simon Peter

answered, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the message of eternal life, and we believe." That's the big picture we gaze into here today on this Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ.

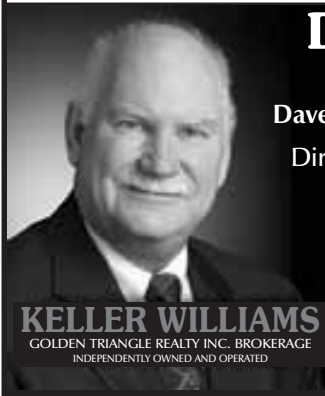
