Sacramental Life

Church policy requires that the Sacraments be performed in the parish located closest to you geographically – unless you are registered and regularly attend elsewhere. At St. Louis, the sacraments of initiation are available to registered and regularly attending parishioners only.

Baptism: Celebrated once a month. Please contact the parish office for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Tuesdays – Fridays before the morning Mass, Saturdays 4 - 4:30 p.m., or by appointment.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least one year in advance of your date. A marriage preparation course is required.

R.C.I.A: Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, preparing adults for baptism and/or to join the community. Please contact the office for further information.

Anointing and Pastoral Care: Our parish community cares about the sick and elderly and the lonely. Please notify the parish office to arrange for Sacrament of Reconciliation, Holy Communion, or Sacrament of the Sick.

Pastoral Care to those in Hospital: Privacy-of-Information laws prohibit the parish from obtaining information about parishioners in the hospital. A family member is asked to contact the parish whenever a parishioner is in hospital and requests a pastoral visit.

Today, the 11:30 Mass will be celebrated in Thanksgiving for the Pontificate of our Holy Father Benedict XVI.

The Canadian Conference Catholic Bishops has issued some liturgical notes for use during the time of transition as Pope Benedict XVI retires and the Cardinals gather to elect his successor.

In the parishes of the Diocese of Hamilton the following Masses may take place in a special gathering of the faithful on a Lenten Weekday.

During the Conclave – Mass for the Election of a Pope

Following the Election - Mass of Thanksgiving

From 2 pm (8pm Rome time) on Thursday, February 28, the name of the Pope is omitted from the Eucharistic Prayer.

When a new Pope is elected his name is included in the Eucharistic Prayer.



As a reminder, all the readings and the Responsorial Psalm for the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sunday of Lent will be taken from the Year A (and not Year C).

During those three Sundays the three Scrutinies for the RCIA candidate will take place after the homily.
