FOR PENTECOST:

(First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11)

"Pentecost" was the Greek name for the Jewish "Feast of the Weeks" that celebrated God's giving of the Law to Moses on Mount Sinai. During the celebration, the Spirit's sudden arrival surprised all who had gathered; the newly reconstituted "Twelve," that included Matthias (newly elected to replace Judas), and a group of disciples numbering over one hundred that included Mary, the Mother of Jesus.

Ten days before, the Apostles bid farewell to Jesus and received their mandate to witness to Him to "the ends of the earth". Now, His promise of "another advocate" is fulfilled. The Spirit comes upon them not as a "sound of sheer silence", but as a rushing, violent wind that shakes the house and makes their hearts tremble. They lose control of their tongues and utter words they do not know, manifesting God's Spirit already working within them.

The Spirit apparently drives them into the streets where "devout Jews from every nation" (Pentecost required adult Jewish men to journey to Jerusalem for the feast) hear the joyous tumult and gather to witness the unfolding marvel. They don't hear cacophonous nonsense, but real words each understands, though they can't understand each other. The barrier between them and God's Word is removed. The Spirit now allows God's Word to penetrate, like an arrow, deep into each human heart. Although they understand the Apostles, there is no mention of improved communication among the language groups. That miracle awaits the work of the Spirit; the Spirit will be the common language of what must become a spirit-speaking Church.







