### For the Sixth Sunday of Easter

St. Peter, in the second reading, points out that following Christ inevitably leads to difficulties, such as being "maligned." But such abuse should not be feared. Constancy in faith will bring shame on those who defame us. We must find comfort in the knowledge that it is better "to suffer for doing good ... than to suffer for doing evil." Peter reminds us that Christ asks nothing of us that He did not first embrace.

No matter how much we might wish it were otherwise, institutional order – and relationships of any kind – requires obedience. "Keep my commandments" does not mean store the tablets safely; it means obey the commandments in every aspect of life.

In the Gospel Jesus says "I will not leave you orphaned". The opposite of being orphaned is living in family. Jesus advises us about how to be a family characterized by love and hope. Twice he stresses the keeping of "my commandments." We won't have to do it alone, Jesus assures us. He is our first advocate before the Father, but he will send "another Advocate," the world can't even "see." Greek word for advocate is a legal term that means "comforter" and "consoler," The Paraclete is a teacher, but in John's Gospel the Paraclete is more *Crown attorney* than *defence lawyer* giving witness to Christ and indicting the world for its lack of faith. Jesus manifests sincere affection for his disciples. When he promises "I will come to you," he does not mean in the Parousia (second coming), but through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.


