

A Word From Our Pastor:

e are very blessed this year at St. Joseph's because we have two opportunities to pray and encourage vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

On the weekend of June 3rd and 4th we will have the opportunity to hear Father Mark Morley at all our masses. Father Morley was appointed as our new Vocations Director last summer by Bishop Crosby. Many of you would know him previously as the Pastor of Sacred Heart of Jesus in Rockwood which is course one of our neighbouring parishes. I will speak more about that upcoming weekend as it approaches.

This weekend we celebrate Vocations Sunday which is proclaimed throughout the Church's world. All of us, no matter our ages, have a call to pray, promote and encourage vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Each of us has a vocation. It can be as a parent, a married spouse, or through a single life. Many of us have vocations to certain careers in the secular world which allow us to help others in need and to offer hope.

However, a vocation to the religious life is a very unique call, for it truly comes from God. Jesus as our 'Good Shepherd', gives the perfect example of striving to seek out a religious vocation. Even if one is not considering a religious vocation, one is called to encourage and act upon the call from Christ to pray for vocations.

The Gospel of John not only shows Jesus as being the Good Shepherd, but also that He is both the Gatekeeper and the Gate. We must see that Christianity is different from other religions and faiths. It is a faith based on the notion of sacrifice. Unlike ancient religions which sacrificed animals, Jesus offered Himself for sacrifice. He became the Sacrificial Lamb for the forgiveness of sins. He calls us to understand what He did for us and to follow Him.

To be a Catholic, to be a Christian, is to practice sacrificial love. We follow and lead through our life of sacrifice. Jesus is the Shepherd who leads us away from predators, however, we must recognize the voice of the

only Shepherd who can save us. Ultimately, we must follow Jesus through the sheep gate, becoming sacrificial lambs ourselves. We do this by going through Jesus, the Gate.

On this Vocations Sunday, we are called to know the Shepherd's voice. Sometimes the Good Shepherd's voice sounds like our own when we dare to ask "Have you considered being a priest?" We know the Shepherd's voice. We must pray that there will be someone to open the gate for us.
