

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

n this Sunday we are blessed to celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord. This feast is always celebrated on August 6th and so this year it overrides the 18th Sunday of Ordinary Time.

This feast was first declared in 1457 by Pope Callistus III. It occurs 40 days before the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross (September 14). On e may be caught off guard by the fact that it was proclaimed to celebrate, of all things, a military victory! The Crusades had defeated the Turks at Belgrade a few weeks earlier. An historical fact that many would not know.

This feast is celebrated in all the Gospels, and it is the second of three times that we hear a voice declaring who Jesus is. When He was baptised in the Jordan by John, as He came out from the waters there was an image whereby the "heavens were being torn open and the Spirit, like a dove, descending upon Him. A voice came from the heavens "You're my beloved Son, with You I am well pleased"." This was the beginning of Jesus' public ministry.

Today, at the beginning of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem and to His death, we hear God, a voice from the cloud, say not to Jesus, but to Peter, James, and John, "This is My beloved Son. Listen to Him."

Finally, we hear a human voice at His death proclaim as He entered into His glory, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!" It was a centurion, a pagan, who recognized who Jesus was. All three images truly state who Jesus was and how we are called to hear the voice of God and other voices as well.

The moment of the Transfiguration is not one in which Jesus is 'changed' and then 'reverted' back to His earthly form, rather, Matthew says that Peter, James, and John are granted a view of Jesus as He is in His divinity. They see His real form. The Transfiguration offers all of us a message of hope and encouragement. In moments of doubt and despair we are called to listen to God's consoling words about His Son: "This is My beloved Son in whom I am well pleased."

I also wish to mention that the Diocese is inviting priests and parishioners to attend meetings on the future of the Diocese as we continue to come out of the pandemic. The Diocese will host meetings based on deaneries. Because the Halton one falls on Saturday November 11th, I will be attending the session of Saturday October 7th at St

Joseph's Church in Guelph. The Diocese also wishes to have six parishioners attend the sessions as well. We already have two parishioners who have committed to this particular Saturday. If you are interested in attending, please feel free to contact me.


