

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

his upcoming week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (December 8). Mary is a beautiful model throughout the Advent season. At a given moment in Salvation history, God asked Her to mother His Son. It was a demanding invitation and one which troubled Her greatly. When She gave Her reply to the Angel Gabriel, "let it be done to me according to your word," the Salvation progress began and from Her humanity came His Flesh and Blood.

To be worthy of such an honour, God graced Her with freedom from original sin from the first moment of Her conception. Mary had to be Immaculate, untouched by sin from the first moment of Her birth. The Mother who was carrying God's Son, not for Herself but for a world in need, could have no hand, act, or part, in sin. Mary became Christ's first Disciple, and the very model of what discipleship means.

The privilege of the Immaculate Conception did not protect Her from doubt or from the anguish and darkness that we are all heir to. She knew how to cope with sorrow and trouble and turn it into hope and joy. At Calvary, when not even His close followers were present or believed in Him, Mary stood steadfast at the foot of the Cross, under the tree of redemption, faithful to the last.

It is the presence of Mary that allows Christ's suffering to enter and dwell in the human heart. We must always see that Mary's life gives us comfort and great hope. This Solemnity is a proper preparation for the Nativity of Our Lord. God calls each of us like Mary, to welcome Jesus and to make room for Him in our lives. If we can say 'yes' like Mary did, then we can live His Word and carry His Cross in a way that can change the world and bring about His Kingdom.
