

#### A Word From Our Pastor:

his week and for the next few weeks until Lent, we will be reading from Matthew's "Sermon on the Mount". Many believe that the Beatitudes which we hear Jesus speaking and proclaiming today is all that the sermon is about. The sermon is about far more than just the Beatitudes. They serve as a preamble to everything that follows.

In the gospels of Matthew and of Luke, which also contains the sermon, we see a summary of the values taught by Jesus. Luke's Beatitudes come later in his Gospel. Matthew, however, places his summary close to the beginning of the Gospel because everything that follows will build on this summary of Jesus's teaching.

You might say that Matthew's Beatitudes are like an orientation. Many of us have experienced an orientation program. Whether it was at the start of a new school year or program, or at a new workplace, we have been exposed to a school/workplace core of values. Sometimes they have been insightful and informative. Other times they have not been helpful in any way, shape, or form.

With Matthew's Gospel, we can see Jesus gathering His disciples and giving them an orientation into Christianity. We are also encouraged to listen to this orientation. Matthew is telling us that this list of Beatitudes is very important.

At the core of the culture of the time of Christ, were the values of honour and shame. Having honour was more important than wealth and power and determined social standing. One was encouraged to seek honour and position at all costs. To fully appreciate the Beatitudes, we must understand that what Jesus presented as values was contrary to what the people had long accepted. In fact, what Jesus taught would have normally brought shame to the individual.

The 'poor' of Matthew's Gospel were not the economically disadvantaged, but rather, those who had lost their honour. Widows and orphans were the most common people of whom Jesus spoke. They were desperate to regain honour and were not shameless to pursue it.

Jesus teaches through the Beatitudes that Christian honour is achieved through the belief that honour comes from a dependency on God. For Jesus, a person does not gain honour on their own, honour is something that comes from God. This is something which we should remind ourselves of often. We need to rely on God throughout our lives.

The Beatitudes give us an opportunity to grow in our relationship with Christ. It is a lesson we need to listen to and learn from.


