

A Word From Our Pastor:

Whith this being the middle of July, gardens and plants are at their full bloom. We are, of course, dealing with a lack of rainwater but still, everything has reached its peak. One thing a novice gardener like myself struggles with is the ability to identify what is a plant and what is a weed. Some weeds have nice flowers which are colourful and confuse some individuals with their appearance. Weeds can also interfere with a good plant which can make them harder to uproot and to be removed.

This image can be used for the Gospel of this Sunday. Last week we had the parable of The Sower and the Seed, this week it is the The Separating of the Wheat and Chaff (weeds). Having acknowledged that there is evil in the midst of the community, this week's parable answers the question of how we are to respond to it. The short answer: Never judge. We will be wrong.

We are reminded today, through this Gospel, that God is the judge and we are not. If this is the case, then what is our role? Our role is basically to model right Christian behaviour. We are called to exercise patience and tolerance towards others until God makes his judgement on all of us.

Weeds and plants do grow together. If we rush to separate them, we end up killing the good along with the bad. God has exhibited kindness, tolerance, and patience when dealing with us. We should practice no less with those who would disturb our peace.
