

A Word From Our Pastor:

f this were not the 17th Sunday of Ordinary Time, we would be celebrating the Fest Day of St. Joachim and St. Anne, the parents of Our Blessed Mother, Mary (July 26). They are not mentioned in Scripture and the one nonbiblical book that speaks of them seems to be totally untrustworthy. How then, can one celebrate a Feast in their honour? One can look upon this Feast Day as being one which honours parenting or, taking it a step further, honouring grandparenting. We have, in our culture, Mother's Days and Father's Days, days which celebrate parents. This Feast Day could be looked upon as an opportunity to celebrate Grandparent's day.

Grandparents have always been viewed as being individuals supporting and guiding their children in helping to raise their children's children. Today, many grandparents have taken on greater responsibilities for their grandchildren. While at one time they were asked to periodically 'babysit', for many the roles have increased substantially. One can be inspired by the lives of St. Joachim and St. Anne who were probably involved in the upbringing of Jesus.

Again, we know nothing Mary's parents or their lives, but it seems likely that Mary learned from them her faithfulness, humility, and her generous surrender to God's action which made possible the birth of Jesus. Perhaps they modelled the self-sacrifice that led her to visit Elizabeth during her pregnancy. St. Joachim and St. Anne were present to guide and instil these Holy attributes in Mary and they can inspire us even today.

On this Feast Day, let us pray for and honour grandparents for all that they do in helping and supporting their children and their children's children. They can teach us so much with their faithfulness and humility just as St. Joachim and St. Anne shared with and passed on to Mary.
