## A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

**W**e are becoming familiar with, as we start another summer with restrictions opening up, and freely enjoying, the summer weather. Our Gospel of this Sunday gives us an example of individuals who were too familiar with a fellow individual. The problem about God and Nazareth was that God came to Nazareth in the form of a local, one of the villagers, and the community could not come to terms with the situation. They did not recognize the obvious – that God is present among people; the truth was staring them in the face, but it was too familiar for them to recognize. Christ's family circumstances were too well known among the villagers, and they felt because He was a native that He had nothing to offer. He was, after all, only one of themselves.
