

A Word From Our Pastor:

s we enter the second part of this year, we can honestly say that we hope it is better ten the first part was. Still, things will be different for awhile. Vacations will be different for most people this summer. Even when people can take vacation there will be restrictions as regards numbers, spacing, accommodations.

People will still want to get away and enjoy the summer weather and catch up on their rest. This is a word which we can take from this Sunday's Gospel passage from Matthew. The word rest is other used in scripture in a variety of ways. Surely there was rest in terms of sleep, but there was little rest in the form of days off or holidays. Most of the time the word rest is used to describe a period after war. To 'rest in the bosom of Abraham" was to be protected and freed from oppression of any sort. This the rest that Jesus offers in our Gospel passage. In His Kingdom, as opposed to in an empire like Ancient Rome, there would be rest.

Jesus does not speak of a world free of burdens, however. In His time there was the burden of Rome and the burden of the laws which the Pharisees placed on the people. One might say that Jesus was offering yet another burden, except the burden Jesus offered was one that came with hope.

This burden of Jesus is the knowledge that the Kingdom He invites us to share is "not yet". With Jesus, our burden is the knowledge that we are close but not quite there. This burden can still provide rest for the weary and those most heavily encumbered.

The Gospel reminds us that Jesus brings us peace. It is not the words peace, freedom from war and suffering, it is the peace that comes with the knowledge that despite war or suffering, God is with us.
