

s a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him." *From Proverb*s

Happy Father's Day to all fathers, stepfathers, and grandfathers on this their special day. Five weeks ago, we observed Mother's Day and offered prayers and blessings for our mothers. Today, this Father's Day, we are doing the same for our fathers.

We are very blessed here at St. Joseph's for the fact that our Parish is named in honour of the earthly stepfather of our Lord. St. Joseph truly represents what a father should be. Even though the Gospels do not record a single word which St. Joseph spoke, he was there, attentively present to Mary and Jesus. This is what mattered the most.
