

A Word From Our Pastor:

he Third Sunday of Lent gives us the beautiful passage of the Samaritan woman meeting Jesus at the well. This is a passage we can read and ponder every year during this Holy Season. It is always read during Year A which we are presently in, but it also can be used in Tears B and C as a substitute for the readings of week three.

Basically, this passage gives us an opportunity to look at the image of the 'living waters' which Jesus offered to the Samaritan woman. Jesus offers to all of us the healing waters which can be poured into our hearts and which allows us to be united to God and eternal life.

We need to see Lent as being a time when we can return to Jesus and put back together our lives in our relationship with Him. We must always desire the hope of belonging in His love.

This is what happened to the Samaritan woman. Jesus gave her the ability to believe that she belonged to God.

We can see in the conversation between the woman and Jesus that her faith was starting to be put back in place. We can notice that her initial response to Jesus of calling Him a "Jew" was an insult. Jesus was patient with her and her responses started to change. She addressed Him as 'Sir', and then as a prophet, and finally, she called Him the 'Christ, the Messiah'. We can go even further by noticing that the Samaritan townspeople addressed Him as being the 'Saviour of the World'.

This warming up to Jesus by her is conversion at work. Conversion starts in many ways with questions and curiosity, which then leads to an inward appraisal of oneself. This finally leads into a belief and a profession of God's presence. In one's heart and mind. This belief must always be nurtured and replenished through the desire to drink and be strengthened with the 'living waters' which Jesus offers to all of us.

This Sunday of Lent reminds us that there are hundreds of individuals throughout

the Church's world who are undergoing the First Scrutiny in the hope that they will be baptized at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. through Baptism, they will experience for the first time the 'living waters' which Jesus offers. The prayer which they will be asked to remember is the hope that their thirst will be quenched.

Those of us already baptized need to be able to do an appraisal of ourselves as well. Do we continually look to have our own thirst quenched by Jesus during our lives? If we are open to this belief and desire, then our relationship with Jesus will be strengthened.


