

A Word From Our Pastor:

ome years ago the Church changed the name of this Sunday. Many have and will continue to call it Palm Sunday because of the distribution of Palms at The Church has, the masses. however, returned to the use of its traditional name which is Passion Sunday. We know that this things are different due to Covid year restrictions. In fact, Bishop Crosby has asked that Palms are not distributed at all during the masses this year because of health concerns. There are unfortunately, some people who only come to the masses this Sunday to 'pick up' the palms.

With this in mind, we need to go back to what the Church has asked us to believe in on this Passion Sunday. We are called to see the Man who defined Christian honour, who defined loyalty to the Father, who defined faithfulness, who defined trust in God. The Cross is the symbol of this day, not the palms.

Passion Sunday begins for us the holiest week we experience as Christians. It spells out for us the last events of the earthly life of Jesus and makes clear the price He paid for our sins. He was betrayed by Judas, denied by Peter, and abandoned by all. His death on the Cross reminds us that we are on a journey towards God, whose friendship we seek. The road to 'eternal life' is not based on by-passing the Cross. Rather, our victory, like Christ's comes only through the Cross.

Let us pray that this Holy Week is one of prayer and of hope. It may look different in some respects, but the importance and significance of the Cross can never be diminished.


