

#### A Word From Our Pastor:

he Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord is an important feast in the liturgical year, but it is one of the less emphasized feasts which people celebrate during the year. Over the years, Church leaders in different countries have shifted the date from exactly 40 days after Easter, to the following Sunday. In Canada this has been the norm for many years. However, in countries like the United States they have for the most part kept the Solemnity as the 40<sup>th</sup> day after Easter. This year it falls on Thursday May 18<sup>th</sup>.

How often in our lives have we been told that we must have faith in a certain matter or a certain individual? We must learn that our life of faith in our relationship with God is not a life of certainty. Our faith is our willingness to believe despite our uncertainty. It is a life of believing and ultimately acting on that belief.

When Jesus says goodbye to His Apostles, He tells them that they will be witnesses to Him. When we think of a witness, we think of a court case. Rather, we must learn that a witness in court is not a person who simply had heard about something occurring. A witness must be seen as being a part of the experience. Jesus asked the Apostles as He asks us to share our experience of Him with the world. In doing so, the believer begins to endure hardship. It is no small wonder that 'witness' and 'martyr' come from the same word.

On the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, we are given a gift from Jesus. What is this gift? It is that through Jesus, heaven is open to us. With this gift, we need to realize that the hardship of fulfilling the mission which Jesus has given us, is worth the price.

Yes, this may be 'heady stuff' which we read and hear today in our Sunday readings, but it is to remind us that Jesus' return to the Father is a blessing for us. It enables the coming of the Holy Spirit which allow us to carry on the work of Jesus. To carry on the work of Jesus is to become aware of His continuing presence. Through the gift of Baptism which we have received, we are allowed to offer the gift to others as well.

On this Ascension Sunday let us have the courage to express the gift which Jesus has given us. Where He has gone, we hope to follow. Our prayer is that the Holy Spirit will work within us to achieve our goal.


