

A Word From Our Pastor:

Leaster Season with the Solemnity of Pentecost. The Pascal candle is moved from its place of prominence in front of the altar after the last Mass. It is returned to its place by the Baptismal font, where it will only be used during the rest of the year for Baptisms and Funerals. This represents the belief that one is Baptized into the death of Christ through His Resurrection. It also shows that the 'Light of Christ' has entered the world and is always present.

On this Pentecost Sunday, as we are reminded of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, it is always appropriate to do a review of them. These gifts which are mentioned in Isiah 11:2-3, show us that they would be present in the Messiah to come and now have been extended to us through the Holy Spirit.

The gift of wisdom makes us relish and only love the things which come from Heaven. Basically, it is the gift of choosing God above all other things. The gift of understanding helps us to grasp the truths of our faith. This gift allows us to achieve a deeper insight into the Scriptures and the Doctrines of the Church.

The gift of counsel (prudence) allows us to see and correctly choose those things that help to give glory to God and guide us toward our own Salvation. It helps us to separate good from evil. The gift of fortitude brings the courage to overcome the obstacles and difficulties that arise from practicing our faith. Being a person of faith, one who openly lives a life of faith, is not always easy. The values of our faith are not always shared by the majority in our world.

The gift of knowledge helps us to know the right path to follow and the dangers to avoid in our journey to Heaven. It enables us to possess the vision of the Kingdom of God and helps us to remain on the proper course. This gift of piety allows us to have the confidence in God which leads us to live a Christian life.

Finally, the gift of the fear of the Lord leads us to show respect for God. This 'fear' does not mean that we become afraid of God, but rather that

we seek to not offend God. We are not afraid of what God will do to us; we are afraid of disappointing God. When we love someone, we always fear hurting them.

These gifts of the Holy Spirit are there for us as individuals. If we use them in a proper and faithful manner, they can be used for the entire community of faith. Jesus' prayer that we may be one with Him and the Father will then be achieved.


