

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

ast week our focus was on the Solemnity of All Saints. This week our focus is the Feast of All Souls which is celebrated the very next day on November 2nd. By the time this bulletin will be published we will have already celebrated this Feast Day. During this whole month of November, we should be praying for all the dearly departed marked with the sign of faith.

If we ponder Heaven with All Saints, then we need to ponder Purgatory with All Souls.

Like many Catholic teachings, the teaching of Purgatory is much maligned. This is too bad. Purgatory is about promise and hope and God's unbelievable mercy. Historically it has been presented as a place of purifying, almost like a fire of redemption.

How we should look at Purgatory is to be reminded that it teaches that we are responsible for our sins, for our "thoughts, words, and deeds". In a world that is increasingly void of any form of accountability, we are reminded that with God we do not escape accountability.

If we think of Purgatory in terms of a verb, that is 'to purge', purgatory is an action of God purging us of our sinfulness. Yes, Jesus won salvation for us, but to be saved does not excuse us from our personal sin. Fortunately, purging our sins in this act of God makes it possible for us to enjoy the salvation won by Christ.

All Souls Day also teaches us about the Resurrection. We are taught that Jesus defeated death and rose from the dead, therefore, the bonds of love that exist in this life do not end with death. When it comes to death, love should not be used in the past tense. We still love those who have gone before us. All Souls Day teaches us that we can continue to act on the love we still have.

What are we praying for on All Souls Day and for the whole month of November? We pray that God "will be merciful in judging our

brother/sister." These words are taken from the funeral rite which we celebrate for those who are faithful but are still in need of our prayers.

We speak of our deceased loved ones being taken into Heaven, yet we want to be wary of merely presuming God's love. Instead, although the Father's love is promised by Christ, we humble ourselves and ask for God's love and mercy.

On All Souls Day, we pray not just for those whom we love. We pray for all who have gone before us. To intercede for others in prayer is a noble thing.


STRUGGLING AFTER AN ABORTION? - Either


