

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

sually as we study and pray the Gospel of St Luke, the central figure in one of the parables from Jesus is that of God. However, this Sunday Luke changes things up in an interesting way. In this passage, the main character, the Unjust Judge, is the focus, not God. This Judge was unjust not because he was corrupt, but because he was not doing the job he was supposed to do, which was to protect the defenseless. The widow in the story would have been the most defenseless of all because normally a widow would have had a male relative take care of her. Typically, only a man would have approached the Judge, thus we would come to the realization that this widow was both alone and desperate. What Luke is teaching us is that if the Unjust Judge will respond to the pleas of the helpless, how much more so will God!

This leads into the idea of prayer on this Sunday. It was once said that God responds to our prayers in one of three ways: yes, no, or wait. The first of these are clearly defined. We can come to a realization or a clarity of yes or no. What we struggle with is God's response to our prayers to wait. We struggle because we live with a 'right now' mentality or world. Not only this but we want it to be easy as well. This is more so because of the advancement of social media and technology.

We need to remind ourselves that the readings of this Sunday are truly good news. They assure us that God does respond to prayer, but we are to be persistent and persevering in prayer. Luke says that with prayer God will always vindicate the just, meaning those who are attached to God. We cannot, however, pray ceaselessly alone, we need to have support for our prayer, thus our need for a community of faith.

Prayer is effective, it changes us. It guides us and it puts us more in touch with our Christian values. It gives us strength to live these values. God responds positively to prayer. We need to remember this and start to pray.






