

#### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

e are blessed this weekend to welcome Deacon Carlos Diaz to serve at our Sunday Masses and preach the Homily. Deacon Carlos is finishing up his studies at St Peter's Seminary in London and

will be ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Hamilton on Saturday May the 6<sup>th</sup> next year.

Since Deacon Carlos is with us this weekend it is a good opportunity to talk about the Deaconate. We can start with a Scripture passage from St. Paul to Timothy: "Deacons likewise must be serious not double-tongued, not indulging in much wine, not greedy for money, they must hold fast to the mystery of the Faith with a clear conscience. And let them first be tested, then if they prove themselves blameless, let them serve as deacons." (Timothy 2: 8-10)

This passage gives us the knowledge that the Deaconate was a very early sign in the Church of service. The word 'deacon' is from the Greek and means 'to serve' and this image continues to this very day in our Church.

What a deacon does today in the Church includes many duties and responsibilities. At Mass he prepares the altar and helps the priest throughout the liturgy. During the Mass he may preach the Homily, help with the distribution of Communion. He also intones parts of the Mass as well. If one observes what the deacon does during the Mass, one will get the sense that there is a certain 'rhythm' to what he does. In fact, if the congregation does not realize or notice the deacon during the Mass, then he has performed his duties in a proper and reverent way.

Some questions that people may have about the deaconate pertain to the two levels of it. Deacon Diaz was ordained to what is called the 'transitional' Deaconate. He was ordained to this back in June He will be ordained to the priesthood next May as I mentioned earlier. His Diaconate is just a specific period of time until someone is ordained as a priest. One must be ordained a minimum of six months before they become a priest.

The other level is known as the Permanent Deaconate. This stage is what it states, an individual has no desire to become a priest, he stays as a deacon. In the Diocese of Hamilton, it has only been the last twenty years that we have seen many Permanent Deacons being ordained. Most deacons are assigned to a specific parish by the Bishop to serve the people and meet the needs of the

community. Some deacons will have other duties as well, for example as prison or hospital chaplains. We have a deacon in charge of our Liturgy Office. What ever the case may be, deacons serve an important role in the Church.

Let us pray for Deacon Diaz as he finishes his studies towards ordination. As well, let us pray for the candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation which we celebrate this upcoming Wednesday November 2.




