

# A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

e celebrate Labour Day this weekend which marks the end of summer holidays for many people, even though there are still three weeks left in the season.

For most young people, it is the last weekend before school begins. I always remember that it was hard for the first couple of weeks to get back into a routine. With school starting again, there are reminders to get up earlier than in the summer months and having the discipline to start doing homework again in the evenings. There are many other things which a student must remind themselves to start doing all over again.

One thing that a student must start over is practising to line up to enter the school at the beginning of the day or at recess. Students must also line up for getting on school buses at the end of the day. This Sunday we are reminded to 'line up' behind Jesus and follow Him. In the Gospel for this Sunday, Jesus is telling His Apostles to follow Him for He is taking them to a new place and belief. In particular, He is telling Peter to follow and not to try to lead.

Jesus asked the ultimate question of Peter and the other Apostles, as He asks us as well, which is how to find meaning in our lives. Matthew's answer is that we find meaning by being willing to get in line behind Jesus and follow Him wherever He leads, even if it means ending up on a cross.

We must always remember that the heart of Christianity is to serve and to serve sacrificially. We cannot serve others and not be willing to sacrifice our lives on the crosses of our life's journey. The sacrifice Jesus asks of us when He says that we must lose our life is not necessarily about death. It is about giving up our self-centeredness, our selfishness, and our temptation to tell God to serve our needs.

Giving ourselves to the Lord in just such a spirit of sacrifice is the only source for providing real meaning in our lives. If we want meaning, we've got to get in line behind the Leader.

This weekend is Eddie MacDonald's last weekend with us before she moves to Espanola to begin her duties working with the Jesuit Fathers. We invite all Parishioners to offer Eddie their best wishes and prayers as well. May God Bless Eddie as she begins her exciting new role.
