THE RISEN LORD

Mary Magdalene and the holy women who came to finish anointing the body of Jesus, which had been buried in haste because the Sabbath began on the evening of Good Friday, were the first to encounter the Risen One. Thus the women were the first messengers of Christ's Resurrection for the apostles themselves. They were the next to whom Jesus appears: first Peter, then the Twelve. Peter had been called to strengthen the faith of his brothers, and so sees the Risen One before them; it is on the basis of his testimony that the community exclaims: "The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!"

Very often in the Gospels, people address Jesus as "Lord". This title testifies to the respect and trust of those who approach Him for help and healing. At the prompting of the Holy Spirit, "Lord" expresses the recognition of the divine mystery of Jesus. In the encounter with the risen Jesus, this title becomes adoration: "My Lord and my God!" It thus takes on a connotation of love and affection that remains proper to the Christian tradition: "It is the Lord!"

Everything that happened during those Paschal days involves each of the apostles - and Peter in particular - in the building of the new era begun on Easter morning. As witnesses of the Risen One, they remain the foundation stones of His Church. The faith of the first community of believers is based on the witness of concrete men known to the Christians and for the most part still living among them. Peter and the Twelve are the primary "witnesses to His Resurrection", but they are not the only ones - Paul speaks clearly of more than five hundred persons to whom Jesus appeared on a single occasion and also of James and of all the apostles.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The second Sunday of the Easter Season was established as **Divine Mercy Sunday** by Pope John Paul II during the celebration of the Jubilee of the Year 2000. This occurred contemporaneously with the canonization St. Faustina Kowalska, a humble Polish Sister who was born in 1905 and died in 1938. This canonization was the first of the new millennium. It is very significant that the Servant of God, Pope John Paul II chose both to establish this Feast of the Divine Mercy and to canonize this humble apostle of Divine Mercy at the very beginning of the new millennium; in doing so he was calling the Church to return to the very essence of the Gospel. At the close of a century unparalleled in brutality, bloodshed and war and particularly characterized in its latter years by what he aptly termed a culture of death, the Holy Father was calling us to rediscover the very heart of the Gospel through the witness of St. Faustina, a messenger of the Merciful Heart of Jesus. Pope Benedict has stated that "mercy is the central nucleus of the Gospel message; it is the very name of God, the Face with which he revealed himself in the Old Covenant and fully in Jesus Christ, the incarnation of creative and redemptive love".

DIVINE MERCY CELEBRATION on Sunday, April 11th at 2:00 to 3:30 p.m. (Exposition and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament, time for reflection, Chaplet) followed by veneration of the relic of St. Faustina. Bring religious items to be blessed. St. Faustina Kowalska was born in Glogowiec, Poland in 1905. On April 30, 1926, she received the habit and her name in religion, Sr. Maria Faustina of the Most Blessed Sacrament. On February 22, 1931, through a vision, our Lord commissioned St. Faustina to have an image painted according to the pattern she beheld in the vision. The Divine Mercy Message and devotion, made known through St. Faustina's writings, have caught on like no other. St. Faustina died on October 5, 1938. She lived an ordinary life in an extraordinary way. Her greatest desire was to be a saint. All she did, she did in union with the salvific work of Our Lord. May this humble servant of Our Lord inspire in us the desire to seek holiness above all else.
