CHRIST IS PRESENT TO HIS CHURCH

Christ is always present to His Church, especially in the actions of the liturgy. He is present in the sacrifice of the Mass, in the person of the minister (it is the same Christ who formerly offered Himself on the cross that now offers by the ministry of priests) and most of all under the Eucharistic species. He is present in the sacraments by His power, in such a way that when someone baptizes, Christ Himself baptizes. He is present in His word, for it is He Himself who speaks when the holy Scriptures are read in the Church. Finally, He is present when the Church prays and sings, for He Himself promised: Where two or three are gathered in My name, I Am there in their midst.

Indeed, in this great work which gives perfect glory to God and brings holiness to men, Christ is always joining in partnership with Himself His beloved Bride, the Church, which calls upon its Lord and through Him gives worship to the eternal Father.

It is therefore right to see the liturgy as an exercise of the priestly office of Jesus Christ, in which through signs addressed to the senses man's sanctification is signified and, in a way proper to each of these signs, made effective, and in which public worship is celebrated in its fullness by the mystical body of Jesus Christ, that is, by the head and by His members.

Accordingly, every liturgical celebration, as an activity of Christ the priest and of His body, which is the Church, is a sacred action of a pre-eminent kind. No other action of the Church equals its title to power or its degree of effectiveness. In the liturgy on earth we are given a foretaste and share in the liturgy of heaven, celebrated in the holy city of Jerusalem, the goal of our pilgrimage, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God, as minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle. With the whole company of heaven we sing a hymn of praise to the Lord; as we reverence the memory of the saints, we hope to have some part with them, & to share in their fellowship; we wait for the Saviour, our Lord Jesus Christ, until He, who is our life, appears, & we appear with Him in glory.

By an apostolic tradition taking its origin from the very day of Christ's resurrection, the Church celebrates the paschal mystery every eighth day, the day that is rightly called the Lord's day. On Sunday the Christian faithful ought to gather together, so that by listening to the word of God and sharing in the Eucharist they may recall the passion, death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus and give thanks to God who has given them a new birth with a lively hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. The Lord's day is therefore the first and greatest festival, one to be set before the loving devotion of the faithful and impressed upon it, so that it may be also a day of joy and of freedom from work. Other celebrations must not take precedence over it, unless they are truly of the greatest importance, since it is the foundation and the kernel of the whole liturgical year. (*Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy of the Second Vatican Council*)

THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday, January 28th, St. Thomas Aquinas, Priest, Doctor. St. Thomas was born around the year 1225 into the family of the Count of Aquino. He studied at the Benedictine Abbey of Monte Cassino and at the University of Naples. He joined the Friars Preachers, also known as Dominicans and became a great teacher. He wrote extensively in the areas of philosophy and theology.

Thursday, Jan. 31st, St. John Bosco, Priest. St. John Bosco was born near Castelnuovo, Italy in 1815. He encountered many difficulties as he prepared for ordination to the holy priesthood. Once ordained, he dedicated himself to the education of the young, eventually founding two congregations dedicated to this apostolate. He died in 1888.

Feb. 1st, First Friday of the Month We honour the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Most Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for adoration from 12 noon until just before the 7:00 p.m. Latin Mass.

Saturday, Feb. 2nd, Feast of the Presentation of our Lord. Today's feast recalls the day that Jesus was brought to the Temple by Mary and Joseph and presented to God in accordance with the law. It was Simeon who acknowledged Jesus as the light to all the nations. ***On this day, candles are blessed during the celebration of Holy Mass. Anyone wishing to have candles blessed are asked to bring them today.*** Additional Holy Mass at 10:30 a.m. (Extraordinary Rite). Please see below.

*Come ce li hanno trasmessi coloro che all'inizio videro e furono poi ministri della Parola. Nell'Esodo sta scritto: Il popolo vedeva la voce del Signore (Es 20,18). Certamente la voce si ascolta piuttosto che vederla, ma così sta scritto per farci capire che vedere la voce di Dio significa possedere altri occhi, che permettono di vedere a coloro che lo meritano. Senza dubbio nel vangelo non è la voce che si vede, ma la Parola, che è superiore alla voce. Gli apostoli hanno visto la Parola, non perché hanno visto il corpo del Signore e Salvatore, ma perché hanno visto il Verbo. Se infatti aver visto Gesù con gli occhi del corpo fosse lo stesso che aver visto la Parola di Dio, in questo caso anche Pilato che condannò Gesù avrebbe visto il Verbo! Gesù, dopo la lettura nella sinagoga, ripiegò il rotolo, lo restituì al ministro e si mise a sedere. E gli occhi di tutti nella sinagoga erano fissi in lui. Anche ora, se lo volete, in questa sinagoga, cioè in questa nostra assemblea, i vostri occhi possono fissare il Salvatore. Quando voi riuscite a rivolgere lo sguardo più profondo del vostro cuore verso la contemplazione della Sapienza, della Verità e del Figlio unico di Dio, allora i vostri occhi vedranno Gesù. Felice assemblea quella di cui la Scrittura testimonia che *gli occhi di tutti erano fissi in lui!* (Origene, *Commento al vangelo di Luca*).*

*"Passando lungo il mare di Galilea, Gesù vide Simone e Andrea suo fratello. Li vide mentre gettavano le reti in acqua perché erano pescatori e disse loro: Seguitemi vi farò diventare pescatori di uomini. Ed essi subito lo seguirono, abbandonando le reti. "Subito": la vera fede non ha dilazioni; come ode subito crede, subito segue. Penso che in quelle reti hanno abbandonato tutti i loro attaccamenti mondani. Quale forza possedeva colui che raccolse intorno a sé uomini semplici e soprattutto poveri di mezzi per realizzare un'opera immensa, cioè disseminare tra tutte le genti le sue leggi e la sua dottrina e insegnare a tutto il genere umano quella religione che adora un unico, supremo Dio. Credette bene servirsi di questi uomini rozzi e semplici come ministri del suo piano divino. Come potevano istruire una moltitudine loro che erano privi di istruzione? Ma in questo modo si dimostra il carattere divino del progetto e la forza divina che agiva in loro. Se consideriamo che in pochi anni, malgrado le persecuzioni, la Parola è stata annunciata su tutta la terra, non possiamo dubitare che questa sia opera divina (Girolamo, *Omelie sui vangeli II*).*"

Con il sangue del tuo Figlio e la potenza dello Spirito tu hai ricostituito l'unità della famiglia umana disgregata dal peccato, perché il tuo popolo, radunato nel vincolo di amore della Trinità, a lode e gloria della sua multiforme sapienza, formi la chiesa, corpo del Cristo e tempio vivo dello Spirito (prefazio VIII del tempo ordinario).
