MASS MINUTES

Liturgy of the Word – The Gospel and the Homily

Pride of place in the Liturgy of the Word is given to the proclamation of the Gospel. The singing of an acclamation befitting the liturgical season, either the Alleluia during most of the liturgical year, or Praise to you Lord, King of eternal Glory, during Lent, precedes the reading of the Gospel. The Gospel contains the words of Christ Himself; special reverence is paid to the Book of the Gospels. The Book of the Gospels is a separate book from the Lectionary, from which the other readings are proclaimed. It is the only book that may be carried in procession during the Liturgy, and when it is used, it is placed on the Altar at the beginning of Mass. A procession often takes place during the singing of the acclamation, at which point the priest or deacon preaching the Gospel carries the Book of the Gospels to the Ambo. The Book of the Gospel is what is processed. If the priest or deacon is reading from the lectionary, only a simple movement to the Ambo is done. He, the priest or deacon, is not processed. The Gospel must be read by a man in Holy Orders: a bishop, priest or deacon. It is particularly appropriate the one in Holy Orders proclaim the Gospel because, by their Ordination, they speak for Christ and the Gospel contains the words of Christ. Before reading the Gospel, the priest may incense the Gospel Book. The response of the faithful at the conclusion of the reading of the Gospel is "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ". This response reflects the understanding of the Church, and that Christ Himself speaks in the Gospel.

Activity for the week

Read the Gospel in advance. Ask yourself, what would you preach about? What is Christ saying to our Parish? Next Sunday, did you and the preacher agree on what God is saying? Was it the same? Was it different? This is an active way of listening to the Gospel.
