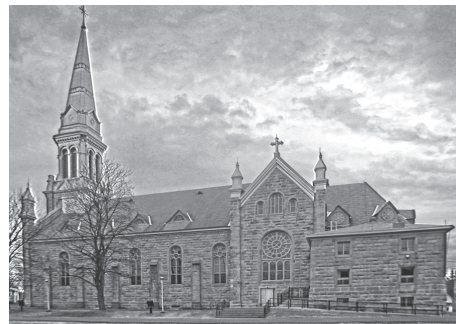

CELEBRATING 125 YEARS AS A DIOCESE (1890 – 2015)

This weekend marks the start of a two-week anniversary Open House exhibit in the chapel of Nativity Church.

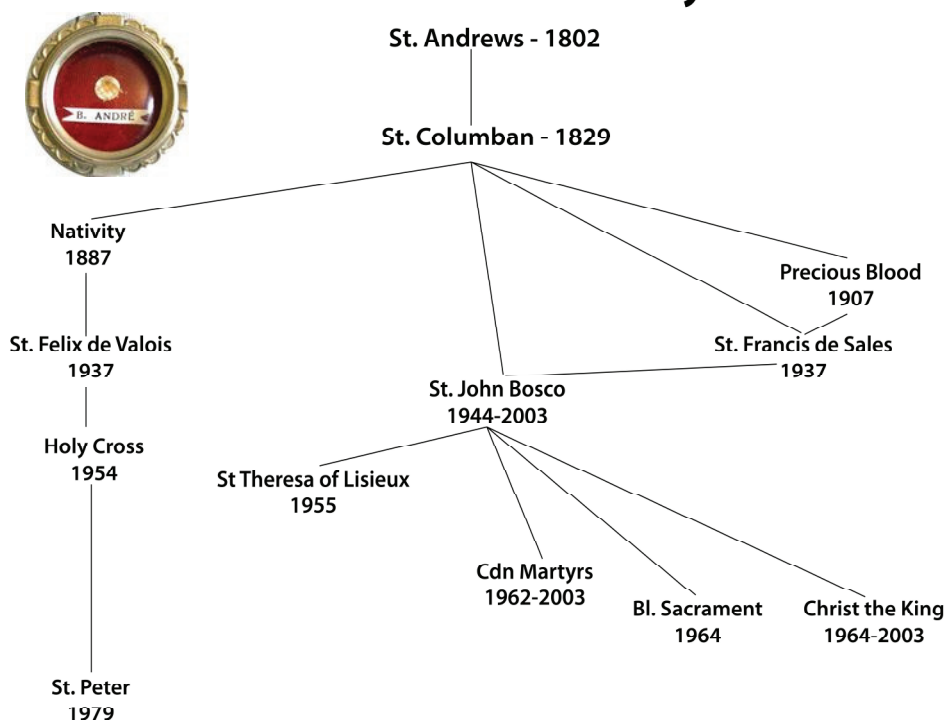
Treasures of the Diocese presents more than 100 artifacts providing a visual history of the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall. Most of the artifacts have not been seen in public in decades.

The exhibition includes portraits, historic photos and documents, vestments, church vessels, and relics. The pieces include:

- The crozier belonging to our first Bishop, Bishop Alexander Macdonell.
- A garnet episcopal ring, a gift from King-George IV to Bishop Alexander Macdonell, the first bishop of Upper Canada.
- A set of fiddleback chasubles that date back to the 1800s.
- Relics of Canadian Saint Brother André.

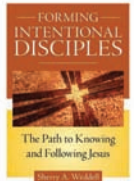
