Think about your own role in your family. How are you being a good shepherd to your child and to your family? Are there any "wolves" in your life, drawing your attention away from the flock God has placed in your care?



Many people mistakenly believe that Easter is one day only. In fact, the Easter season goes on for 50 days, ending on Pentecost! The Church spends 50 days celebrating the great news of Christ's resurrection. During this time, we read stories of Jesus visiting with the apostles, the same apostles who thought that His death on the Cross had been the end. Both the Ascension, when Jesus is taken up into Heaven, and Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit comes down upon the apostles, are important parts of this Easter season.

#### MASS ATTENDANCE DURING NEW STAY-AT-HOME ORDER – STARTING APRIL 19. 2021

The Provincial Government has extended the stay-at-home order until May 20, 2021. The new changes will affect Mass attendance in that we are only allowed ten (10) people per Mass and this includes Deacon Guy and Fr. Ernest. #### St. Joseph the Worker - May 01
