The term **Octave of Easter** refers to the eight-day period (**octave**) in Eastertide that starts on **Easter Sunday** and concludes with the Sunday following **Easter** (**2**nd **Sunday of Easter**, or **Divine Mercy Sunday**). The **Octave Day** or the **Octave Sunday** refers only to that day, **Divine Mercy Sunday**.




