When we think about the raising of Lazarus, do we place our focus on "I am the resurrection" and not remember that Jesus also says "I am the life?". It is important to realize that it is not just the death of Jesus but the *life* of Jesus that brings about salvation. For the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, through which "we have all received grace upon grace" (John 1:16).




