The stories and parables told by Jesus tell of the importance of preparing for our future and the need for wholehearted trust in God. Jesus promises blessings to the watchful, warns of judgement if we are not ready, and promises blessings to the person who is found doing God's work when the master returns, but judgement on the person that didn't prepare or do what was expected of him.


