Jesus' message is hard but honest. No one who hears and considers his words could ever feel misled about the cost of discipleship. But also, no one who hears and considers his words could ever doubt that there is no other choice to make than surrendering to him as Lord, no other destiny worth pursuing than eternity in his presence. In eternity, there *is* peace. But until then following Jesus will also cause division.


