God is speaking to your heart and there is a door of salvation before you -- a narrow door -- but it is still open to you. And Jesus calls you -- no, commands you -- "Strive, struggle to enter through the narrow door." Do it now, don't wait. For the day will come when the door will be abruptly shut, and unless you are inside God's household, it will be forever too late.


