

MASS ATTENDANCE DURING PROVINCE-WIDE REOPENING PLAN

Ontario entered stage 3 of the reopening plan on Friday, July 16, 2021. Stage 3 allows indoor religious services, rites and ceremonies, including weddings and funerals at 50% capacity of the room. Outdoors religious services, rites and ceremonies, including weddings and funerals, will be permitted with capacity limited to allow physical distancing of 2 metres. Parishioners must still maintain Covid protocols with social distancing of 2 meters and wearing masks.

SAFETY PROTOCOL

SAINT OF THE WEEK BLESSED ANDRE GRASSET – September 02

Blessed André Grasset was born in Montreal in 1758. His family had come to Quebec in 1749, but they returned to France after the Battle of Quebec. Ordained a priest, André was serving at the cathedral in Sens when the French Revolution began. Refusing to sign the Civil Constitution of the Clergy, he and many other priests and religious were imprisoned in 1792 and martyred. As one of a group of 190 martyrs, André was beatified in 1926. The following year a college in his name was opened in Montreal.
