The point of the gospel today is twofold. First, we are not to devote our lives to the gathering and accumulation of wealth. If money is your master that means God is not. The second point is the fact that we are not blessed by God to hoard our wealth to ourselves.

We are blessed to be a blessing in the lives of others, and we are blessed to build the kingdom of God.


