The words of Jesus, "I do choose. Be made clean!", healed the man with leprosy. Might we also need to kneel before Jesus requesting the healing for which all of us yearns? Today each of us can choose to accept the challenge to love our neighbour and decide to serve our brothers and sisters that are in need.


