

ENVELOPES AND PARISH REGISTRATION

If you are new to the parish, please pick up a Registration Form located at the Fourth St. Entrance. You can drop it in the Collection Basket or the mailbox at the Rectory. You can also bring it to the Rectory during regular business hours. The registration form allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish and allows parish staff to contact families when necessary. It also allows the church to provide a yearly tax receipt. Registration means that we want to gather each Sunday with our brothers and sisters in Christ to worship God and that we want and intend to support the ministries in our parish. Registration is a concrete sign that the family is involved in the life and work of the parish.

We encourage you to take this Lenten Challenge to commit to a specific hour once a week. There is a prayer "request & thank you" book in the Chapel. Feel free to add your intentions, and we invite you all to pray for those requests. The library is open, and there are hundreds of excellent books. Feel free to take books home and either pass them on or bring them back. There is no time limit on them. Thank you for remembering to sign in and out of the Chapel.

Here is a reminder of our three important rules.

- Please do not admit anyone who does not have a fob issued to them. That means not answering the door. It may seem inhospitable, but it is essential for the safety of everyone.
- 2. If you choose to bring someone who is not registered, you are responsible for staying with them until they leave.

 Please do not leave people there who are not registered.
- 3. Remember to close the doors of the enclosure around Jesus in the monstrance.

We encourage you to invite friends to join the Chapel team of adorers. Bring them with you the first time. Show them the procedure of signing in and out, opening and closing the doors of the enclosure and the library... and then have them call or email the names and numbers on the sign on the door. We ask for contact information, the parish if they have one, some details about them and how they heard about the chapel. Recommendations make that easier for us.
