Matthew makes the point in his Gospel today that prophecies of old are fulfilled in Jesus. It also states that Jesus learned of John the Baptist's arrest and resolved to begin his ministry away from Herod. Jesus also called with some urgency, his first four disciples.

The common thread to all this was that God's Kingdom was at hand.


