EVANGELIZATION: A CHALLENGE FOR THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Several years ago, Fr. Bob Bedard, founder of the Companions of the Cross community of priests, produced a powerful small booklet entitled: 'Evangelization: A Challenge for the Catholic Church'. In that booklet we are reminded: "The Gospel is something we must choose to follow. It is not meant simply to be listened to and admired. It is not something primarily to study or talk about. I must do more than consider it, I must answer the call of the Gospel with a resounding 'yes'. I must embrace it with my whole being ... It involves making Jesus the Lord of my life and entering thereby into a personal relationship with Him ... Evangelization is the process whereby a person hears the Gospel, embraces it fully, makes Jesus Lord of his life and gets involved in a lively, intimate and ongoing relationship with Him."

Bedard continues: "By and large, the experience our Catholic people receive in our churches and schools is a positive one. But it lacks the life-changing power that the Lord would endow it with if only we would evangelize in the full sense of the word. We have to begin again to understand what evangelization is and how it works."


At a recent Catholic Day of Renewal in Montreal, the first presentation addressed the state of the Church with respect to declining attendance and the fact that we've forgotten our primary identity and mission (evangelization). Next up was helping parishes to embrace the New Evangelization (personal relationship with the Lord, focus on the Holy Spirit, reception and activation of charisms needed for the work). The third talk focused on ways that we become intentional in achieving these goals. The fourth talk examined the need to call forth, form and support leaders with vision.

In a Day of Renewal in Toronto, one of the presenters, Michelle Moran, made some very interesting observations. Moran noted that many of us have "lost our expectant faith" and that "God goes where He's welcome".

Last April saw Ottawa host the first ever North American **New Evangelization Summit**, with our diocese operating one of the remote linked sites. The Diocese is onboard again this year as one of the 29 NES remote, live-streamed sites. The broadcasting of the event will provide a way for Catholics from around North America to participate in the Summit. The 2016 Summit is scheduled for the weekend of April 15-16; please save the date.

New on the presenters' slate this year is Colorado-based Sherry Weddell, cofounder of the Catherine of Siena Institute and author of the books 'Forming Intentional Disciples: The Path to Knowing and Following Jesus' and 'Becoming a Parish of Intentional Disciples'. Weddell is one of the foremost leaders in this important and timely effort to renew the Church one disciple at a time.
