We meet many obstacles and sometimes feel our children simply don't hear us. But the seed that falls on good soil (and our children are good soil) will produce an enormous yield. We need only not to be discouraged nor give up in the face of obstacles. We should all reflect on the times in our lives when we have seen good seed grow and reap a tremendous harvest.



ST. JULIEN'S CHAPEL REOPENS

Hello friends of Jesus. We are so happy to pass on the good news about the reopening of the Chapel this Saturday, June 13th, at noon. In order to open the Chapel safely important guidelines will need to be followed. Space here does not allow a complete list of these new guidelines.



However, a maximum of 3 people will be allowed in the Chapel at any one time, and only people with fobs will be allowed entry. For now, only regular adorers with fobs can enter. The doorbell will not be answered. The hour coordinators for each hour will be making telephone calls to ensure that everyone is well informed of all guidelines.

PLEASE NOTE

On First Friday of the Month, August 7th, there will be no Adoration, and Confessions are by appointment only until further notice.

SCAM ALERT: An email scam targeting members of Catholic churches and institutions across Canada is active in the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall. In some places, the scam is transmitted by text messages.

Typically, someone purporting to be a priest—or even a bishop—sends an email with a plea for electronic gift cards, notably untraceable iTunes gift cards, to be sent to another address so that they may be given to someone in need or used for a fundraising event. In some cases, the scammers take the act a step further: they ask the victim to scratch the backs of the cards and give them the revealed PIN to allow them to access the cash value.

The scam has been previously reported by several other dioceses in Canada and the US, and there are reports of parishioners who have lost money to a fraudster pretending to be the pastor of a parish. One Ottawa parishioner sent \$1,100 to a fraudster pretending to be their parish priest.

If you receive such an email message or text, confirm it is genuine before responding in any way; it is likely a scam. Exercise caution when checking email messages.


