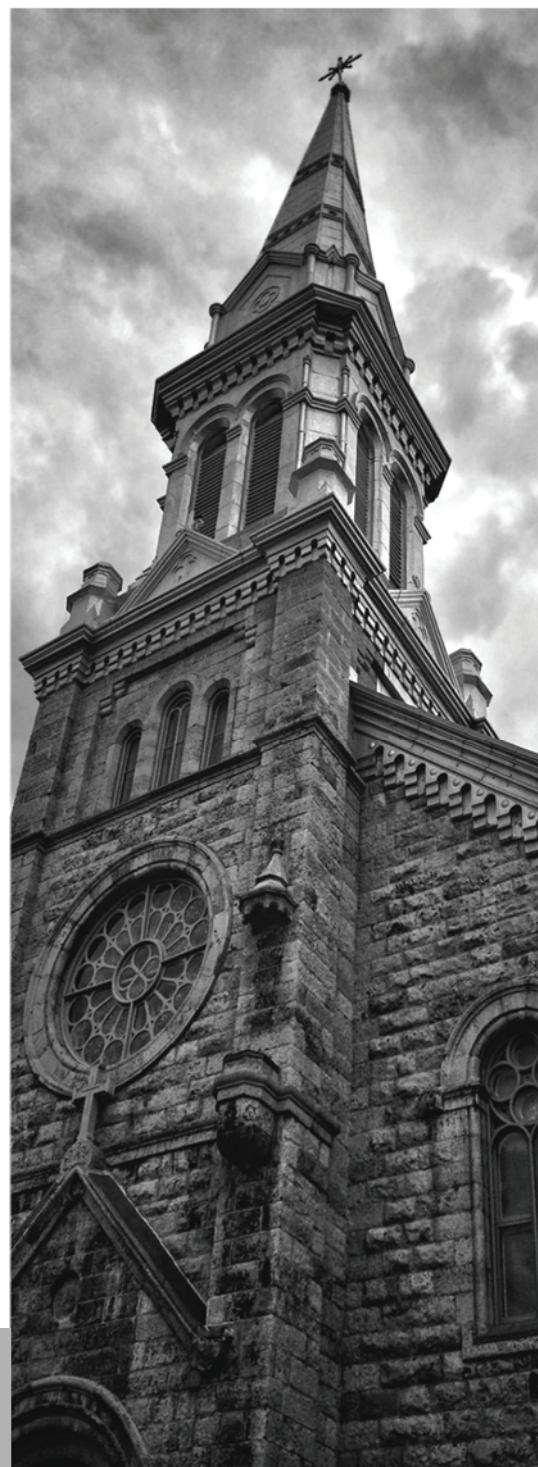

PAPAL VISIT TO CANADA

With this announcement, the Vatican confirmed the Holy Father will make three stops during his visit to Canada: Edmonton, Québec, and Iqaluit.

Every Friday, Centre 105 hosts a visit from the Recovery Care Mobile Clinic. They often hear from Mel, the nurse who attends, that one of the top issues she sees is foot and leg problems.

If you have any used shoes that are still in good condition, we will be collecting them over the next few weeks; the boxes are at the entrance of the Church.
