SAINT OF THE WEEK – SAINT ANTHONY ZACCARIA – July 5

Anthony was born in Cremona, Italy, in 1502. Both a physician and priest, he was greatly inspired by Saint Paul. Anthony was the founder of the Clerks Regular of Saint Paul (known as the Barnabites from their headquarters at the church of Saint Barnabas in Milan). He encouraged the laity to work with the clergy in helping the poor and promoted the frequent reception of communion. Anthony died in 1539 at age 37 and was canonized in 1897. Living with Christ

ST. JULIEN'S CHAPEL UPDATE

We have updated the "Rules" for the Chapel:

- We are allowing up to 5 people at a time, so it is very rarely filled
- There are hours each day when there is no one with our Lord. Please check updated charts and make corrections.
- It is no longer necessary to sign a Covid tracking sheet.
- Sanitizing what your hands have touched should be sufficient.
- We are asking that you do not answer the door for now at least. The doorbell has been disconnected for the time being.
- If people wish to sign up for a job, they receive one usually within 2 or 3 days.
- Don't hesitate to invite friends whom you think might be interested.

THE SANCTUARY LAMP



The sanctuary lamp is a special lamp that is kept close to the tabernacle. The sanctuary lamp remains alight to indicate and honour the presence of Christ.

The living flame of the sanctuary lamp signifies the Eucharistic presence of our Lord Jesus Christ. Sponsorship of the Sanctuary Lamp is available for a week-long period. The stipend is \$20.00 per week, and the intention will be listed in the bulletin.
