

**(F)** Feast – Are of second importance and consist of the celebration of certain saints (Archangels & most Apostles).

**(M)** Memorial – Are next in importance for saints, and those saints who are of "universal significance" are observed by the whole Church. These are Obligatory. **(OM)** Optional Memorial – Not Obligatory.

The National Conference of Catholic Bishops publishes an annual *Ordo* that outlines proper celebrations throughout the liturgical year.
