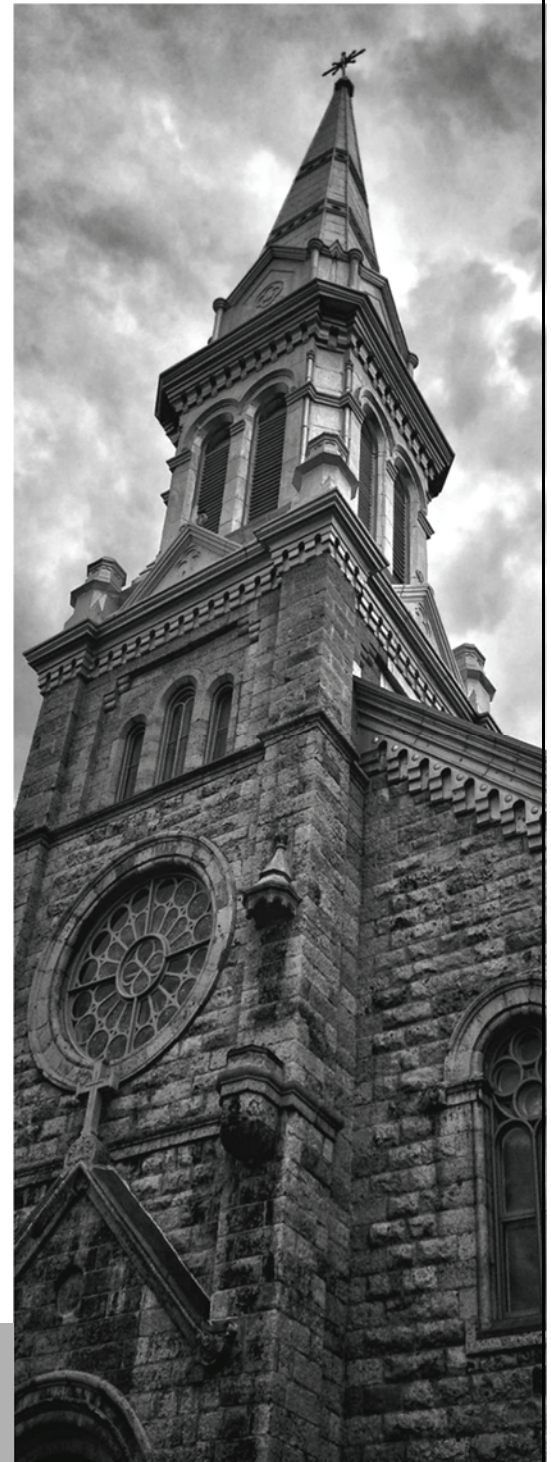

POPE FRANCIS NAMES FR. DOUGLAS J. LUCIA AS NEW BISHOP OF SYRACUSE

Syracuse, NY – Pope Francis has appointed a new bishop for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse. Bishop-elect Douglas John Lucia, 56, of the Diocese of Ogdensburg will become the 11th bishop of Syracuse. Bishop-elect Douglas J. Lucia will be ordained and installed as bishop at Syracuse's Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception located in downtown Syracuse on Aug. 8.

Bishop-elect Lucia was born on March 17, 1963. He was ordained to the Ministerial Priesthood at St. Mary's Cathedral in Ogdensburg on May 20, 1989, by Most Reverend Stanislaus J. Brzana, DD, STD, Bishop of Ogdensburg.

In his first assignment, Bishop-elect Lucia served as parochial vicar at St. Patrick's Church in Watertown, N.Y. In 1990, he was sent to the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall, Ontario, Canada for two years of service where he was parochial vicar at St. Columban's Church in Cornwall. Congratulations Fr. Doug on your appointment to Bishop.
