

#### **FAMINE RELIEF FUND**

Sometimes the Media covers famines, unfortunately they often don't do it until it is almost too late (even we can be a bit slow to realize the situation.) In February, the UN Secretary-General declared 20 million people to be at risk of death in the next six months in South Sudan, Somalia, Yemen, and Nigeria. This particular humanitarian crisis stems from a conjunction of events that include armed conflicts coupled with severe droughts brought about by climate change.
