Like the three would be followers of Christ in the Gospel, we also find it difficult to detach ourselves and because we are so rooted, we don't move immediately when He calls. God will, however, bless reluctant discipleship. This is Good News, because it means that God does not grade us with an indelible "F" when we sin or protest or offer excuses. Every failure is an invitation to repentance and blessing.


