Pow Wows are powerful Indigenous gatherings where you'll find multiple generations coming together to enjoy food, honour traditions, forge a sense of community, and practice spiritual healing. The Pow Wow begins at noon with the Grand Entry. The Feast is at 5 pm followed by the Round Dance at 7 pm. Admission is free though donations are appreciated.
