Jesus does not intend for us to go through life blindly accepting everything that we see or hear. He says, "By their fruits you will know them" (Matthew 7:20), indicating that there is such a thing as proper discernment. We are surrounded by both good and bad and need to be able to discern which is which. Problems arise, however, when our discerning turns self-righteous—when we fail to acknowledge that we, too, are sinners.


