## FINAL CALL – 2015 DISCOVERY STUDY SIGN-UP

In a recent presentation in Ottawa by Father Dimitri Sala:

Salvation is a gift; have we accepted the gift? God told us in His Word what it means to be saved. There is more to being a Disciple than church attendance and Baptism. He's given us '**Terms of the Covenant**' to know whether or not we've received the gift:

1.) Am I under conviction of sin? The Bible tells us that all of us have sinned & fall short of the glory of God. Conviction of sin is knowing that I'm hopeless, helpless, desperate and lost and that no amount of good intentions is going to save me.

2.) Am I willing to repent once and for all, taking that problem of sin, our identity issue, and laying it before God, saying: "I don't want to be a sinner any more, but I can't do anything to change it. I need:

3.) the finished work of Jesus; I want to put my faith in Jesus on the Cross. And so,

4.) I submit my sin to Him; I accept Him as my personal Saviour. And then

5.) I surrender my life to Him as Lord. The final term of the covenant is external and that is

6.) Baptism. Each Baptized person owes it to himself to be sure that (s)he has actually received the gift by embracing the gift offered to us. Our parents' and god-parents' faith must become our own.

One of the key aims of DISCOVERY is helping us to come to the understanding that Christians are called to have a personal, intimate relationship with Jesus – a relationship of ongoing Intentional Discipleship, where we submit to His Lordship.

We are called to choose to allow Jesus to have His rightful place at the very center of our lives. For the non-Christian, Jesus is not a conscious part of their lives and their choices are not made in reference to Him. There are also those who would consider themselves Christian, but only treat

Jesus as one of many things in their life. The Intentional Disciple seeks to keep Jesus at the center with all other things as secondary.

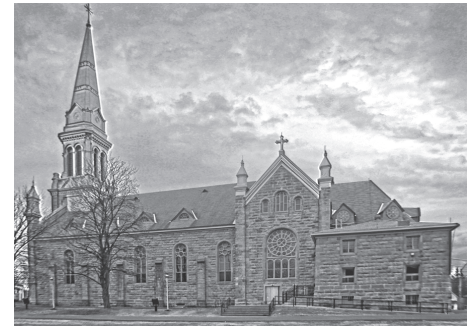

## IN OUR PARISH

### SPONSOR-A-CANDIDATE

We ask you to become a part of our St. Columban's parish project. The project asks people from the parish to pray for a grade 2 pupil who is preparing for the Sacraments of Initiation. As part of the program we ask:

- That you pray for this child during this school year.
- That you write a series of three short notes. This is important so every child gets a note or card.

We have approximately 75 children this year. Please reach out with a spirit of evangelization and pray for a child. Volunteers will be at entrances of the church at all Masses the weekend of Nov 7-8<sup>th</sup> to assist you with selecting a child.

### PRIESTS PENSION COLLECTION – 1 NOVEMBER

Effective 1 July 2014, due to your generosity, the diocese was able to increase the monthly pension from \$750. to \$800. Considering the current cost of rent, cable, telephone, internet, food, automobile expenses, clothing, entertainment & some amount for miscellaneous, we require about \$2,100. monthly. CPP and OAS provide approximately \$1,000. monthly. This gives us the \$1,100. we have set for our pension goal. We will work gradually to reach this level & hope to increase the monthly pension to \$875 effective 1 July, 2016.
