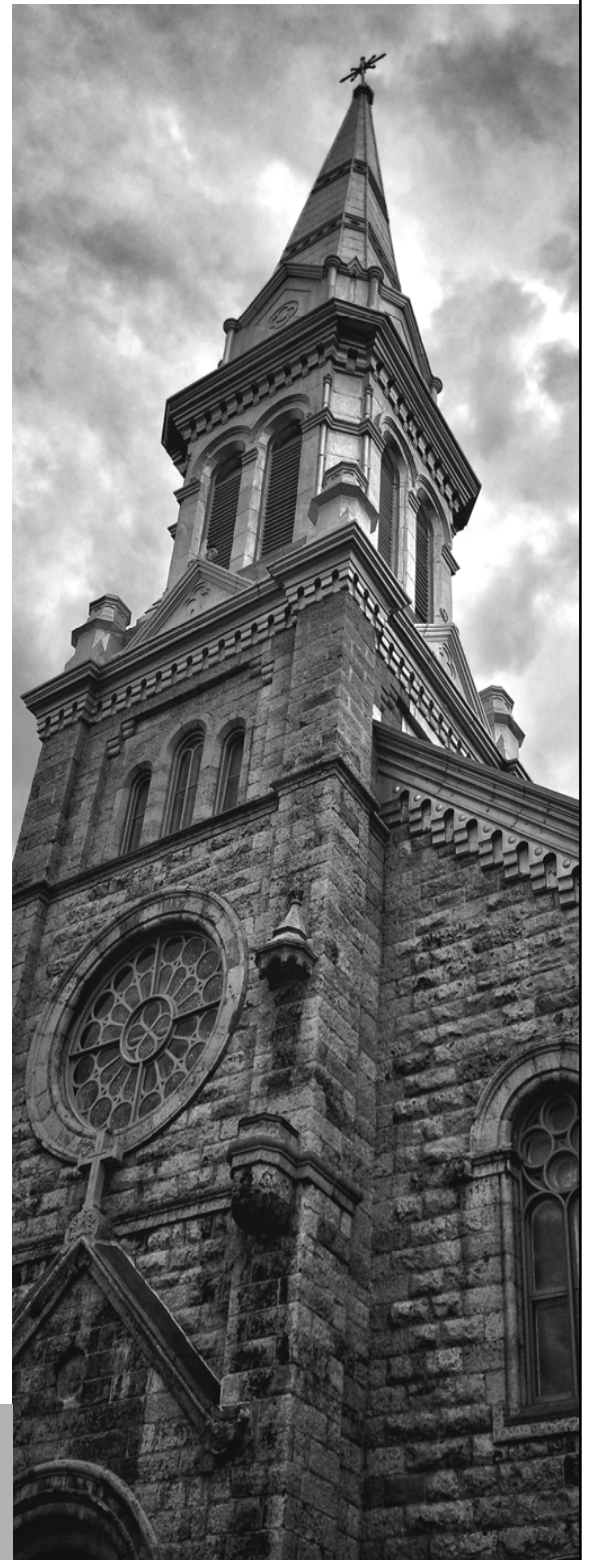

Member of Parliament for Cornwall 1878-1882, Stormont 1883-1896. Former Lt. Colonel commanding the 59th Battalion a precedent unit of the current SD&G Highlanders. Founder of the Royal Canadian Army Medical Corps & Canada's First Surgeon General. His funeral Mass was celebrated at St. Columban Parish on Oct 22, 1896 with Fr. Corbet presiding. Many distinguished guests attended including Sir Charles Tupper (one of the Fathers of Confederation). The cortege left St. Columbans and proceeded to Flanagan's Point for the burial (see page 60 in our history book). Dr. Bergin was recently honoured with an Ontario Heritage Trust Plaque which was unveiled at the Cornwall Armouries on Nov. 08, 2016 the Plaque will be permanently installed at Precious Blood Cemetery in Glen Walter.
